The Welsh Summer Classic Committee, the Executive of The Welsh Pony & Cob Association of Ontario, and the owner & management of Erin Fairgrounds will not be responsible for any claim resulting from injury or injuries to any person, horse or pony, or loss or damage to property, incurred on the show grounds.

The WPCAO is concerned about the well-being of all animals at the show. This code of conduct outlines what is expected of exhibitors in the handling and exhibiting of the animals. There will be no tolerance for any mistreatment or care of animals. It is expected that all exhibitors will adhere to this Code of Conduct.

- 1. To ensure the health and welfare of all animals participating at the show.
- 2. To protect the integrity of all livestock at this show.
- 3. To project an accurate and responsible message about animal care to the public.

The Committee reserves the right to decline any entry and to return any entry fee before or during the show, without being liable for compensation.

In the case of horses or ponies being entered and not exhibited, entry fees will be forfeited. Refunds on entries will be made only on receipt of a Veterinarian Certificate attesting to the inability of the animal to participate due to illness or injury. The certificate must be in the hands of the Show Secretary prior to the beginning of the show on Sunday, July 14th, 2024. Should the show committee cancel the remaining classes due to bad weather, those entries **who** attended the show will be refunded their entry fee less 15%. It is the responsibility of the entry to be at the in gate prior to their class. **NO REFUNDS** will be given for missed classes. Substitution of animals will not be permitted, with the exception of the criteria listed above.

The Welsh Summer Classic is held under the auspices of The WELSH PONY AND COB ASSOCIATION OF ONTARIO and is a HIGH POINT SHOW for the Association's High Point Awards.

Advance entries must be received by July 8th, 2024. No entries will be accepted for any class once the show has begun. All entries must be made prior to the first class at 8:30am. All entries made the day of the show will be subject to a \$25.00 late fee per animal.

Competitors must have proof of a minimum of \$1,000,000.00 LIABILITY INSURANCE.

- For the benefit of the announcer, when filling in your entry form, please use a separate line for each **handler/rider/driver** if showing the same animal.
- Registration papers MUST be available for each animal entered in this show on the day that you show.
- Ponies entered in the Breeding and High-Point eligible Performance Classes of this show must be registered Section A Welsh Mountain Ponies, Section B Welsh Ponies, Section C Welsh Ponies of Cob Type, Sections D Welsh Cobs or registered Half Welsh (with one registered purebred Welsh Parent). Foals must be eligible for registration.

- Entries are restricted to members of the Welsh Pony & Cob Association of Ontario. To apply for membership, please complete a 2023 membership form and forward to the show secretary along with the appropriate fees prior to the advance-entry closing date. For those just entering in the Sport Pony Division, a day membership is required.
- Stallions are not permitted in Junior classes. Juniors are not allowed to ride, drive or handle stallions or intact colts in any WPCAO or Sport Pony classes."
- Any dog on the premises must be on a leash at all times.
- Winners of cups, trophies and other prizes which are held for annual or repeated competitions will be required to execute an agreement to properly care for said prizes and return them to the show committee when so requested for the following year's show.

## \*WINNERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR CARE & ENGRAVING OF TROPHIES\*

- All drivers 14 years of age or under MUST be accompanied by an adult capable of giving assistance.
- The Show Committee reserves the right to combine, cancel, or divide a class.
- Schooling will be allowed only in designated areas.
- All questions not covered by these rules shall be decided and interpreted by the Show Chairperson, along with the Committee Members, whose decision shall be final.
- Any unruly animal will be excused from the ring.
- The show committee reserves the right to make changes to the show schedule of classes by combining classes with less than 2 entries if deemed warranted.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to be fully cognizant of the rules and class specifications governing their division.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitors to know which of their ponies are eligible for Championships and to have them ready and in the show ring on time.
- Please notify the Show Secretary of scratches and tack holds at least two classes in advance. Classes will be held no longer than 5 minutes.
- No exhibitor and/or pony may enter the ring once the judging has commenced.
- All Junior exhibitors must wear approved protective headgear (ASTM/SEI) at all times when handling a pony in the ring, or when mounted or in a carriage driving vehicle while anywhere on the show grounds. Headgear harness must be secured and properly fitted to the helmet. Any rider violating this rule at any time can immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is properly in place. It is the responsibility of the rider, or the parent, guardian or trainer of the junior exhibitor, to see that the headgear worn complies with appropriate safety standards for protective headgear intended for equestrian use, and is properly fitted and in good condition. The Show Committee and Licensed Officials are not responsible for checking headgear worn for such compliance.
- Whips are restricted to 75 cm in length in all line classes, including showmanship.

THE ANIMAL SHOWN MUST BE REGISTERED IN A HALF WELSH REGISTRY OF A WELSH PONY & COB SOCIETY, OR IF A FOAL, BE ELIGIBLE FOR REGISTRATION. TO BE JUDGED ON CONFORMATION AND WAY OF GOING. \*\*\*Canterbrook Farms has continued their \$600 sponsorship for 2024 which will go towards the 2 & Under Half Welsh class at the All Welsh & Summer Classic. Points will be combined (following the WPCAO High Point systems) from the two shows. Ponies must be registered Half Welsh (or eligible for registration if a foal of the current year) and have shown at both the All Welsh & Summer Classic to be eligible for this prize money. Awarding will take place at the AGM.\*\*\*

#### SPORT PONY DIVISION

This division is open to any registered or unregistered pony meeting the sport pony criteria, i.e. hunter, jumper, driving, eventing, etc. The first place in each of the line and under saddle classes will qualify to enter the Royal Agricultural Winter Fair Sport Pony Division. If the 1<sup>st</sup> place pony has previously qualified this year then the 2nd place pony will advance. It is the RESPONSIBILITY of the 2<sup>nd</sup> place handler to obtain this information at the time of placing from the 1<sup>st</sup> place handler. Ponies will be measure at the Royal and MUST be 14.2 and under in order to compete. General EC rules for Sport Horses apply.

At the ROYAL the SPORTPONY STARSEARCH winner will be awarded the perpetual MORTON SPORTPONY STARSEARCH CHALLENGE CUP, a silver keeper plate & our sponsors DENWORTH EQUINE MANAGEMENT Sherri Whitworth-Denouden & Jeremy Denouden, award a total of \$1000.00 prize money to the top 4 and a cooler to the SUPREME CHAMPION.

IN ORDER FOR THE CLASS WINNER TO QUALIFY FOR THE ROYAL THERE MUST BE AT LEAST 2 ENTRIES IN EACH CLASS.

GRAND CHAMPION & RESERVE: Eligible are Junior & Reserve Champions and Senior & Reserve Champions. Champion Ribbons to be awarded.

#### **PERFORMANCE DIVISION** – STARTS IMMEDIATELY AFTER BREEDING DIVISION

 Senior Showmanship: Exhibitors must be 18 years of age or over as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. Handler to be judged on the presentation of his or her Welsh Pony, Cob or Half-Welsh. Prize Sponsored by Greenhawk Saddlery of Orangeville. Ribbons awarded to 5<sup>th</sup> place.

#### JUNIOR DIVISION

A JUNIOR IS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO HAS NOT REACHED HIS OR HER 18<sup>TH</sup> BIRTHDAY AS OF JANUARY 1<sup>ST</sup> OF THE CURRENT YEAR.

Stallions are NOT PERMITTED in the Junior Division. Hard hats with proper safety harness must be worn in under-saddle and driving classes for both English and Western attire, without exception. See show rules and regulations

Leaders for leading rein classes must be 14 years or over and suitably attired. Riders unable to control their ponies will be asked to leave the ring for their own safety and for the safety of others in the class.

- Junior Showmanship 10 years old & under as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. Handler to be judged on presentation of his/her Welsh Pony, Cob or Half-Welsh. Prizes sponsored by KC Farms. Ribbons awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- Junior Showmanship 11 to 17 years old as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year. Handler to be judged on presentation of his/her Welsh Pony, Cob or Half-Welsh. Prizes sponsored by The Cleaning Guy Inc. (1<sup>st</sup> 6<sup>th</sup>). Ribbons awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- Lead Line Equitation WALK ONLY Rider to be judged. Riders 7 years and under as of January 1 of the current year are eligible. Open to Section A, B, C, D, & Half Welsh mares and geldings. Riders in this class are <u>not</u> eligible for any other ridden class. This class is sponsored by Gentle Breeze Welsh. Ribbons awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- 24. Lead Line Equitation Rider to be judged. Riders 12 years old & under as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year are eligible. TO WALK & TROT. Open to Sections A, B, C, D, & Half Welsh. Riders in this class are not eligible to enter Class 26 or 27. This class is sponsored by Wray Acres. Ribbons awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- Lead Line Pleasure Pony to be judged. Riders 12 years old & under as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year are eligible. TO WALK & TROT. Open to Sections A, B, C, D, & Half Welsh. Riders in this class are <u>not</u> eligible to enter Class 26 or 27. Ribbons awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place.
- 26. <u>Walk/Trot Equitation</u> Rider to be judged. Riders 12 years old & under as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year are eligible. Open to Section A, B, C, D, & Half Welsh. Riders in this class are <u>not</u> eligible to enter Class 24 or 25. This class is sponsored by Wray Acres. Ribbons awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place.

<u>Walk/Trot Pleasure</u> – Pony to be judged. Riders 12 Years Old & under as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year are eligible. Open to Sections A, B, C and D & Half Welsh. Riders in this class are not eligible to enter Class 24 or 25. This class is sponsored by J Hoover Ltd. Ribbons awarded to 6<sup>th</sup> place.

#### NOTE: RIDERS IN CLASSES 23 to 27 ARE NOT ELIGIBLE FOR ANY OTHER RIDING CLASSES

#### **DRIVING DIVISION**

GENERAL INFORMATION:

Drivers 14 years of age or under MUST be accompanied by an adult. Ponies to be shown to a suitable 2 or 4 wheeled vehicles (no viceroys or jog carts). Type of the arness is optional, but must be suitable to the vehicle used. Adult or junior drivers are permitted, except where otherwise specified. Drivers must carry a whip. A hat, gloves, and a driving apron are encouraged. To be shown both ways of the ring at a flat-footed walk, ordinary trot, and strong trot. To stand quietly and back readily. To be judged 60% on manners, performance and style and 40% on breed type and conformation. Classes may be combined if the entries are low but will be pinned individually.

- Welsh Pleasure Novice Driving Pony/Cob Open to Section A, B, C, D & Half Welsh. Pony/Cob to be in their first 2 years of showing to be eligible. This class is sponsored by Greenhawk Saddlery of Cambridge. Ribbons awarded to 5<sup>th</sup> place.
- 29. <u>Half-Welsh Pleasure Pony to Drive</u>. This class is sponsored by Greenhawk Saddlery of Whitby. Ribbons awarded to 5<sup>th</sup> place.
- 30. <u>Welsh Pleasure Pony to Drive Sections A & B:</u> This Class is sponsored by Bahrs Saddlery. Ribbons awarded to 5<sup>th</sup> place.
- 31. <u>Welsh Pleasure Pony/Cob to Drive Section C or D:</u> This class is sponsored by Bahrs Saddlery. Ribbons awarded to 5<sup>th</sup> place.

- 33. <u>Champion Pleasure Driving Pony/Cob</u> Open to Sections A, B, C, D & Half Welsh. Eligible are 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place ponies from classes 29, 30 and 31. This class is sponsored by Greenhawk Saddlery of Campbellville. Ribbons awarded to 5<sup>th</sup> place.
- <u>Open Welsh Working Driving</u> Open to Sections A, B, C, D & Half Welsh. Driven by a Junior or Adult. To be judged 100% on manners, performance and style. This class is sponsored by Greenhawk Saddlery of Barrie. Ribbons awarded to 5<sup>th</sup> place.

#### UNDER SADDLE DIVISION

<u>GENERAL INFORMATION:</u> TO BE SHOWN UNDER SADDLE IN ENGLISH OR WESTERN TACK. ASTI OR BSI APPROVED HARDHATS WITH PROPER SAFETY HARNESSES MUST BE WORN.
